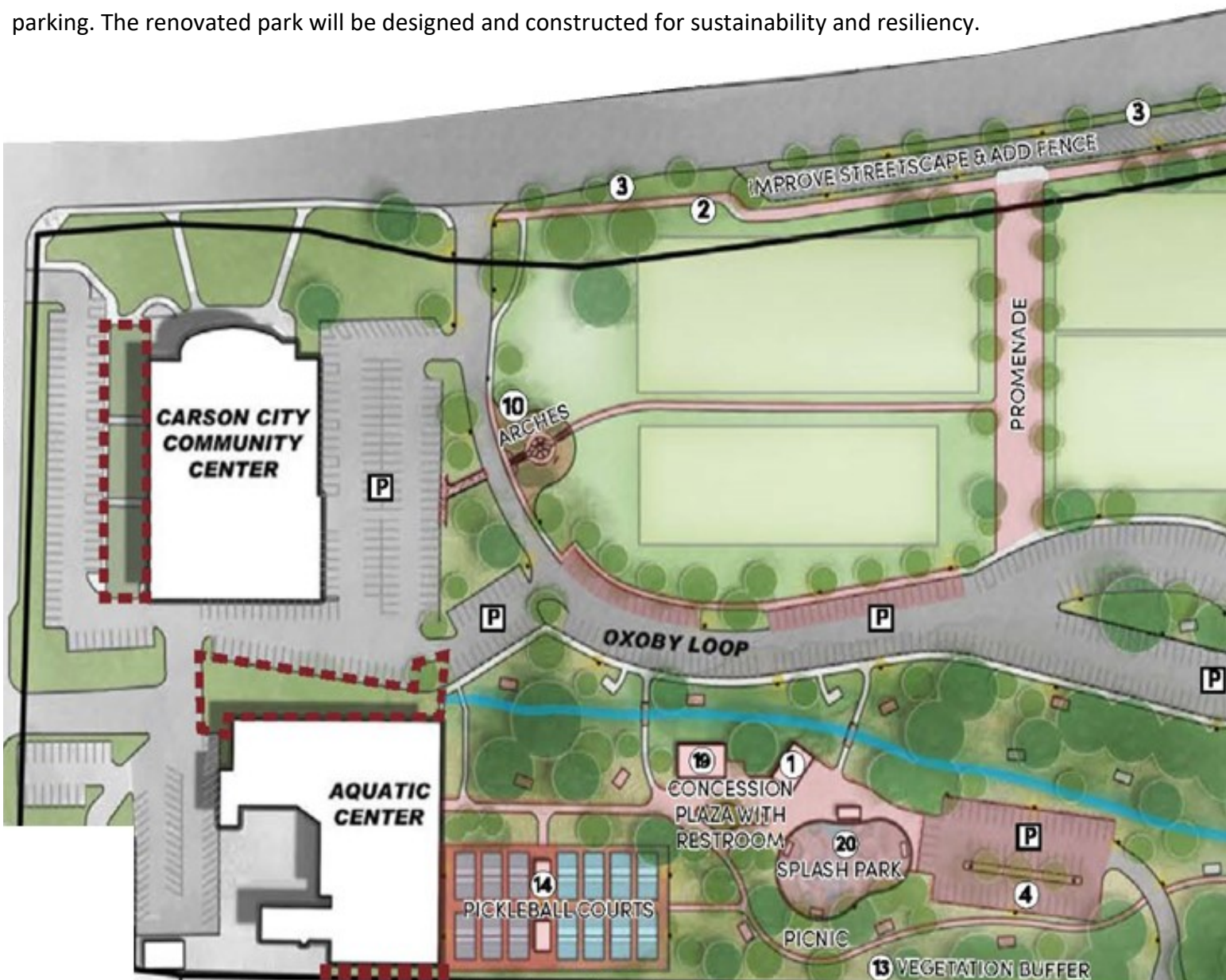

# 14.9 MILLION DOLLARS IN MILLS PARK IMPROVEMENTS

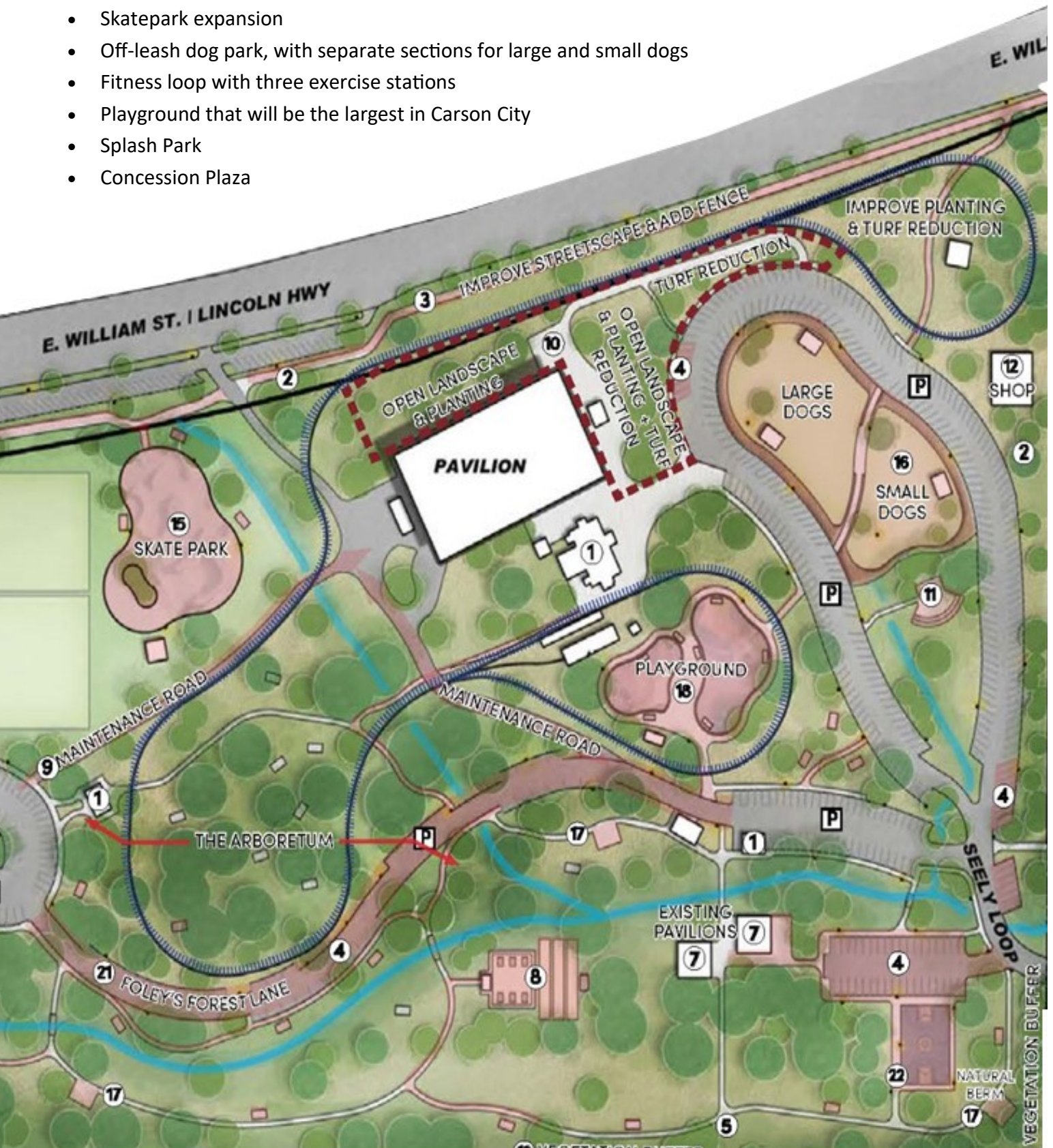
With the recently awarded SNPLMA grant for nearly 15 million dollars, Carson City will renovate the 53-acre Mills Park in Carson City, Nevada, to implement improvements from the Mills Park Master Plan to preserve the park's natural aesthetic and design, while creating a cohesive user-friendly park that responds to the concerns and needs of the community. This project will renovate Carson City's primary regional park, which is currently a high maintenance property with many outdated facilities, crumbling infrastructure, and insufficient parking. The renovated park will be designed and constructed for sustainability and resiliency.





Further, the project will protect and preserve culturally significant sites, and construct or restore other facilities and amenities to reimagine Carson City's primary regional park. Project components will enhance public opportunities for recreation, education, community-based events, and activities, some of which will be new and unique to Carson City. Some of the proposed attractions include:

- Basketball court
- Skatepark expansion
- Off-leash dog park, with separate sections for large and small dogs
- Fitness loop with three exercise stations
- Playground that will be the largest in Carson City
- Splash Park
- Concession Plaza

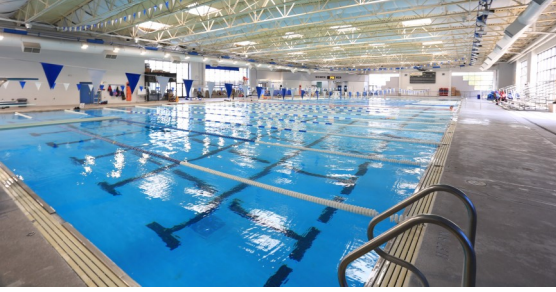

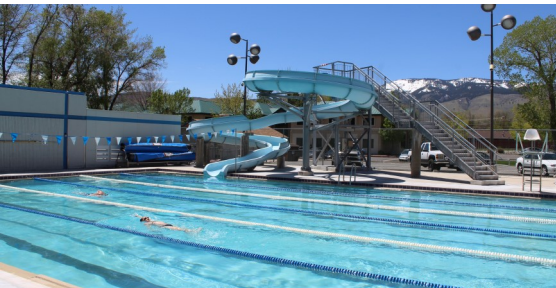
## INDOOR PARENT/TOT POOL

- For children 6 and under with a participating adult.
- Children must be within reach of an adult (15+) at all times.
- Swim diapers are required for children who are not potty-trained.
- Pool depth 6 inches to 3 feet.
- Pool temp. 86—88 degrees.



## ADULT THERAPY POOL (AGES 18+)

- Designed to assist swimmers with physical challenges or recovering from an injury.
- Ramp and lift available.
- Pool depth 2.5 feet to 5 feet.
- Pool temp. 91—93 degrees.



## OUTDOOR POOL

- 6 (25 yard) lanes.
  - 16 ft. tall open flume water slide.
  - Pool depth 3.5 feet to 6 feet.
  - Pool temp 79—81 degrees.
- Season: May 6 - September 20 (times and programming may vary).  
**Slide Schedule:** Fridays 1:30pm-4:30pm; Saturdays 12:30pm-4:30pm

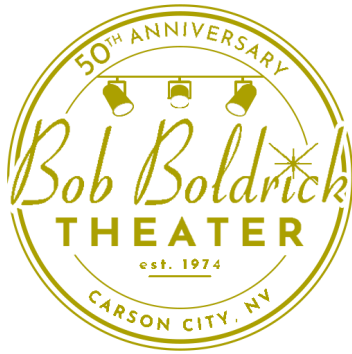
